ACADEMY OF FREEDOM SCHOLARSHIPS – These scholarships are designated for Academy of Freedom majors and those students who plan to enter the Academy. ACTEEN SCHOLARSHIP – The HPU Acteen Scholarship is based on the Acteen’s achievement in Mission Quest with the actual award determined by quest achieved.

The scholarship is available to Howard Payne University students beginning the freshman year provided the student enrolls for a minimum of twelve (12) credit hours. The scholarship is renewable with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.50 and a minimum of twelve (12) credit hours each semester. The scholarship is not available during summer sessions or mini-terms. The scholarship is available for a maximum of eight (8) long consecutive semesters and may be applied to tuition only. A letter from the local Acteens Director or WMU Director verifying the quest achieved is required.

ALL-STATE MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP – Awarded to both state (Texas or any other state) and Baptist All-State Band and Choir members who are music majors or minors. Scholarship award is \$250.00 per long semester during the freshman and sophomore years as long as the student meets all other requirements. No scholarship application or audition is required. Verification of participation is required. Applicants should contact the Dean of the School of Music at 325-649-8500.

ALUMNI ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP – Awarded to dependents of HPU alumni as selected by the Scholarship Committee of the HPU Alumni Association. For further information and an application, contact the HPU Alumni Office at 1-800-950-8465.

AWANA SCHOLARSHIP – The HPU Awana Scholarship award will be determined by the student’s level of achievement in Awanas.

The scholarship is available for the freshman year provided the student enrolls for a minimum of twelve (12) credit hours. The scholarship is renewable with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.50, and a minimum course load of twelve (12) credit hours each semester. The scholarship is not available during summer sessions or mini-terms. The scholarship is available for a maximum of eight (8) long consecutive semesters and may be applied to tuition only. A letter from the local Awana Director verifying the level of achievement is required.

BAPTIST GENERAL CONVENTION OF TEXAS SCHOLARSHIPS – The BGCT funds some scholarships that require certain criteria and must be evaluated each year. Information and applications may be requested by contacting marcy.strube@bgct.org.

Administrators at the Baptist Building in Dallas, TX make confirmation of these scholarships.

TEXAS BAPTIST MEN CHALLENGER’S SCHOLARSHIP – The Challenger’s Scholarship is based on the number of personal development activities completed.

The scholarship is available to incoming freshman and may be applied to tuition only. The scholarship is available for a maximum of eight (8) long consecutive semesters with full-time enrollment and a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.50. A letter from the local Challenger leader or state Brotherhood office verifying the level of achievement must be submitted.

CHURCH MATCHING SCHOLARSHIP – HPU will match designated church gifts for HPU students up to, but not exceeding, \$500.00 per semester. No matching scholarships will be given for summer sessions or mini-terms. A list of scholarship provisions and requirements for the HPU Church Matching gift programs is provided on the Church Match Scholarship Application. The deadline to apply for this scholarship is AUGUST 1st. This application is available in the Office of Financial Aid and on our web-site at www.hputx.edu.

DANIEL BAKER EX-STUDENTS ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP – Descendants of Daniel Baker alumni may apply for this scholarship. General Scholarship Application is required. Selection of recipients is normally made in conjunction with Homecoming.

DEPARTMENTAL SCHOLARSHIPS – These scholarships are awarded by the individual departments. Scholarships are generally awarded on the basis of a student's talent or achievement. Each department has its own criteria and eligibility requirements. Contact the appropriate dean to make application for departmental scholarships.

GENERAL SCHOLARSHIPS – There are numerous general endowed scholarships listed in the HPU Catalog. Eligibility requirements for the scholarships differ from scholarship to scholarship. Some eligibility restrictions are fields of study, cumulative grade point average, classification, and student's residency. Others are designed to assist worthy and/or needy students. Letters of recommendation are helpful. Additional information can be obtained from the Office of Financial Aid.

HARRIS FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP – This scholarship is available to graduating seniors of Brown County High Schools. Maximum scholarship is \$ 1,500.00 per semester renewable for a maximum of six (6) long consecutive semesters with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.00 and may be used for tuition only. Full-time enrollment is required (minimum of 12 credit hours each semester). The Harris Family Scholarship Application is available in the Office of Financial Aid. Priority date for application is March 15.

BAPTIST MINISTERIAL SCHOLARSHIP – Southern Baptist ministerial students applying for this scholarship must present a license, certification of ordination, or letter of certification from a Southern Baptist Church, and meet all requirements set by the Christian Education Commission of the Baptist General Convention of Texas. Application must be obtained from and approved by the Dean of the School of Christian Studies prior to each registration period and cannot be made retroactive during a semester. The scholarship is \$750.00 per semester and applies to tuition only. Eligibility for the \$750 scholarship requires fulltime (a minimum of 12 credit hours) enrollment.

BAPTIST MINISTER'S CHILDREN SCHOLARSHIP – Unmarried children, who are 23 years of age or less, of active Southern Baptist ministers or those of Southern Baptist ministers who are inactive due to age or health, will be entitled to receive a \$ 750.00 per semester scholarship. The scholarship applies to tuition only. The student must enroll for a minimum of twelve (12) credit hours each semester the scholarship is received. Application must be obtained from and approved by the Dean of the School of Christian Studies prior to each registration period and cannot be made retroactive during a semester.

HPU SIBLING GRANT – Students who are enrolled full-time at HPU and have one or more siblings, who are also enrolled full-time at HPU, will qualify for up to \$250.00 per semester. Students must be enrolled full-time and must be from the same household in order to qualify. Awards are considered on a semester-by-semester basis.

PHI THETA KAPPA SCHOLARSHIP – Awarded to active members of Phi Theta Kappa International Honor Society who are planning to transfer to Howard Payne University. Ten (10) scholarships are available to be awarded each academic year. The Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship is awarded in lieu of the Transfer Academic Scholarship at any level. The amount of scholarship award is \$2,500.00 per semester and applies to tuition only. The scholarship is available for a maximum of six (6) long consecutive semesters and can not be used during summer or mini-terms. Full-time enrollment and a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.50 is required. Verification of Phi Theta Kappa membership must be submitted prior to award. This scholarship can be used in combination with the Phi Theta Kappa Academy Transfer Scholarship not to exceed tuition.

STATE SPEAKERS TOURNAMENT – HPU has established a scholarship for the winner of the state Speaker's Tournament. The student must place 1st, 2nd, or 3rd at the state finals level and provide verification of placement. The scholarship is \$1,500.00 per semester and must be used the fall semester immediately following high school graduation. The scholarship is available for a maximum of eight (8) long consecutive semesters if a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.15 is maintained. The scholarship applies to tuition only. The student must enroll for a minimum of twelve (12) credit hours each semester the scholarship is received.

CHARELEY D. AND MARY S. SWINDLE ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP – Applicants must have resided in Mills County for a period of at least five (5) years prior to their beginning date of enrollment at HPU.

WICHITA FALLS AREA STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP – Priority given to students who are members of Baptist churches in the Wichita Falls area, including those from Texas counties of Wichita, Archer, Clay, Baylor, and Wilbarger.
