<b>Dean's Scholar</b>	\$60,000	\$15,000	\$7,500	(Top 25% at an Accredited High School or 3.40 GPA) AND (ACT 24 OR New SAT 1160 OR Old SAT 1090 [Math + Crit. Reading])
<b>Yellow Jacket Scholar</b>	\$56,000	\$14,000	\$7,000	(Top 50% at an Accredited High School or 2.50 GPA) AND (ACT 19 OR New SAT 990 OR Old SAT 910 [Math + Crit. Reading])
<b>Academic Incentive Grant</b>	\$28,000	\$7,000	\$3,500	Awarded to students who demonstrate strong academic promise. *Those who receive this grant may move up to the Yellow Jacket Scholarship level following their second consecutive semester. This move in scholarship level is based upon the successful completion of the Provisional Program, as certified by The Collegium. Such increase in a scholarship award may require adjustment of the total aid.

<b>Central Texas Scholarship for First-Year Students</b>	\$60,000	\$15,000	\$7,500	Awarded to high school students who graduate from a high school in one of the following counties and are unconditionally admitted: <b>Bell, Blanco, Bosque, Burnet, Coke, Concho, Coryell, Erath, Fisher, Gillespie, Hamilton, Hill, Hood, Johnson, Jones, Kendall, Kerr, Kimble, Lampasas, Llano, Mason, McLennan, Menard, Nolan, Palo Pinto, Runnels, Schleicher, Shackelford, Somervell, Stephens, Sutton, Taylor, Tom Green and Williamson counties.</b>
<b>Legacy Scholarship for First-Year Students</b>	\$60,000	\$15,000	\$7,500	Awarded to high school students whose parent or grandparent graduated from Howard Payne University.

<b>Academy Scholar – Level I</b>	Full-Tuition	Full-Tuition	Full-Tuition	(Top 10% at an Accredited High School or 3.80 GPA) AND (ACT 29 OR New SAT 1350 OR Old SAT 1290 [Math + Crit. Reading]) 3.25 Cumulative GPA required for renewal. A maximum of 5 awards will be made.
<b>Academy Scholar – Level II</b>	\$74,000	\$18,500	\$9,250	(Top 25% at an Accredited High School or 3.65 GPA) AND (ACT 27 OR New SAT 1270 OR Old SAT 1200 [Math + Crit. Reading]) 3.25 Cumulative GPA required for renewal. Awards are limited.
<b>Academy Scholar – Level III</b>	\$66,000	\$16,500	\$8,250	(Top 33% at an Accredited High School or 3.50 GPA) AND (ACT 24 OR New SAT 1160 OR Old SAT 1090 [Math + Crit. Reading]) 3.25 Cumulative GPA required for renewal. Awards are limited.

*Students graduating from a Home School will be evaluated for scholarship based on GPA and test scores and/or the county of residence at the time of graduation.*

<b>Yellow Jacket Transfer Scholar</b>	\$14,000	\$7,000	2.00 Cumulative GPA based upon transferable credit from a regionally accredited institution.
<b>Transfer Academic Incentive Grant</b>	\$7,000	\$3,500	Awarded to students who demonstrate strong academic promise.

<b>Central Texas Scholarship for Transfer Students</b>	\$15,000	\$7,500	Awarded to first-time transfer students who graduated from a high school in one of the following counties and are unconditionally admitted to HPU: <b>Bell, Blanco, Bosque, Burnet, Coke, Concho, Coryell, Erath, Fisher, Gillespie, Hamilton, Hill, Hood, Johnson, Jones, Kendall, Kerr, Kimble, Lampasas, Llano, Mason, McLennan, Menard, Nolan, Palo Pinto, Runnels, Schleicher, Shackelford, Somervell, Stephens, Sutton, Taylor, Tom Green and Williamson counties.</b>
<b>Legacy Scholarship for Transfer Students</b>	\$15,000	\$7,500	Awarded to first-time transfer students whose parent or grandparent graduated from Howard Payne University.

*Transfer scholarships are awarded to students who have completed a minimum of 12 transferrable credit hours following high school graduation. Transfer scholarships are not awarded to students in the first academic semester immediately following high school graduation and college hours obtained through dual enrollment classes will not be considered when determining scholarship eligibility. Official college transcripts are required to substantiate the cumulative GPA and the number of transferrable credit hours.*

*Students who graduated from a Home School will be evaluated for scholarships based on the county of residence at the time of high school graduation.*

	Annual Award	Semester Award	Eligibility Criteria <i>The scholarship awards below are for tuition only and may be combined with other scholarships on this flier.</i>
<b>Baptist Ministerial Dependent Scholarship</b>	\$1,500	\$750	May be awarded to unmarried children (23 years old or less) of active Baptist ministers, or those of Baptist ministers who are inactive due to age or health. The scholarship is for tuition only and the student must be enrolled full-time. An application must be obtained from and approved by the Dean of the School of Christian Studies (325.649.8403) prior to the first semester's registration period. Renewal review occurs annually.
<b>Baptist Ministerial Scholarship</b>	\$1,500	\$750	May be awarded to Baptist ministerial students who present a license, certification of ordination, or letter of certification from a Baptist Church and meet all requirements set by the Theological Education Council of the Baptist General Convention of Texas. An application must be obtained from and approved by the Dean of the School of Christian Studies (325.649.8403) prior to the first semester's registration period. Renewal review occurs annually.
<b>HPU Sibling Grant</b>	\$1,000	\$500	Full-time students at HPU who have one or more siblings also enrolled at HPU full-time will qualify for \$500/semester. Siblings must be from the same household. Awards are considered on a semester-by-semester basis.
