Applicants must meet 2 of the 3 Admission Criteria. Admission criteria includes GPA of 2.6 or higher, Class Rank of 50% or higher, and/or official Test Scores (ACT 19 or higher/SAT 990 or higher/CLT 64 or higher).

Awarded to students who demonstrate strong academic promise. Grant may move to Yellow Jacket Scholar after first semester and upon successful completion of the Provisional Program, as certified by the Center for Student Success. Increase in scholarship award may require adjustment of total aid

Awarded to high school students who are unconditionally admitted to HPU and graduate from a high school in one of the following counties: Brown, Callahan, Coleman, Comanche, Eastland, McCulloch, Mills and San Saba

(Top 10% at an Accredited High School or 3.80 GPA) and (ACT 29 or SAT 1350 or CLT 91); 3.25 Cumulative GPA required for renewal; a maximum of five awards made

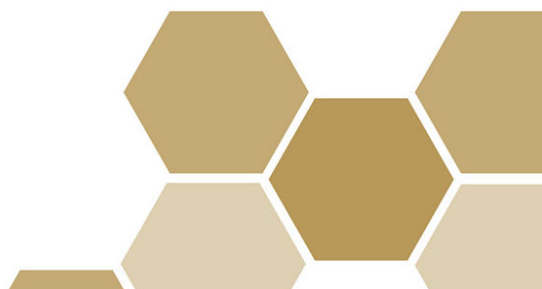
Full-time students at HPU who have one or more siblings also enrolled at HPU full-time will qualify. Awards are considered on a semester-by-semester basis.

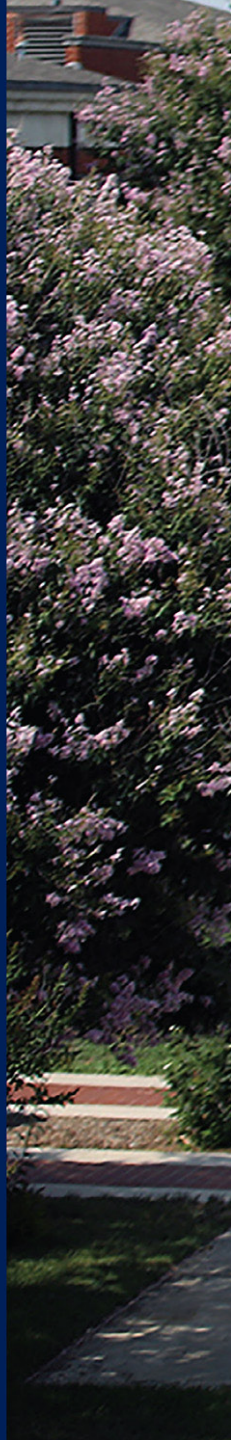
